Dr. Powers is a geriatric psychiatrist and neuropathologist and is a leading authority on Alzheimer's Disease and other forms of dementia. He serves as the Director, Bureau of Geriatric Psychiatry, Alabama Department of Mental Health and Retardation. He also holds appointments as Associate Director of the Brain Resource Program at the University of Alabama at Birmingham (UAB); Senior Scientist, Alzheimer's Disease Center at UAB; Staff Pathologist, Birmingham Veteran Affairs Medical Center; Chief Psychiatrist, Mental Retardation Division, Alabama Department of Mental Health and Retardation; and he is a member of the Board of Trustees, Alzheimer's Foundation of America (AFA). Dr. Powers has contributed to many scientific journals, is a renowned nation-wide trainer as well as developer of dementia-related educational curricula, and is an advocate with the U.S. Congress and state legislatures throughout the nation on behalf of patients and families.
